**IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ CONDITIONS OF ENTRY OVERLEAF**

## Conditions of Entry

All information given on this form should be complete and correct at the time the entry is submitted. You should advise any changes to the Organisers, in writing, as soon as possible. This entry covers one unit (frame tent, motor home or caravan etc.). No transfers can be permitted without the Organisers' written agreement. Refunds will not be made if you cancel your attendance.

Monmouthshire, Brecon and Abergavenny Canals Trust ('the Organisers') reserve the right to refuse any entry without giving any reason. If you wish to receive an early advice that your entry has been received and accepted before 1st April 2010 please enclose a stamped and self-addressed envelope with your entry.

You confirm that you will hold third party insurance to a minimum amount of £1,000,000 for at least the period that the camping unit is to be present at the Festival. For small camping units, the insurance requirement to cover against third party liabilities may be covered by house insurance policies. You should check your insurance policies and contact the Organisers in the event of any difficulty.

You agree not to leave any litter, or cause pollution to the Festival site or the waterway and towing path, or the surrounding area. This includes not leaving excrement from pets on the Festival site or surrounding area. The Organisers will provide litter bins and separate bins for animal excrement.

You agree not to cause a nuisance to other people near by, whether by excessive noise or any other activity.

You agree not to store on your camping unit any article of a flammable or explosive character (for example, fireworks) other than fuel and lubricants, as allowed for under the Boat Safety Scheme. This is for everyone's safety in the unlikely event of a fire. Gaz, butane and propane bottles are exempted from the above.

You agree to comply with the directions of the Organisers, including from the Campsite Manager and his or her team. The decision of the Organisers as to the allocation of camping sites and other arrangements is final. You agree not to change the camping site designated to you without the agreement of the Campsite Manager.

You accept that you are responsible for the conduct of all members of your camping unit (i.e. those people that this entry covers overleaf) including any children and pets, at all times and in all places.

The Organisers will not be held responsible for any loss or damage, other than that to which the Organisers are legally liable as a result of their negligence. You should ensure that you have adequate insurance to cover any accidents or other losses. The Organisers will not be liable for any default due to any act of God, war, fire, flood, drought, tempest or other event beyond the reasonable control of the Organisers.

Block bookings will only be accepted for bookings received by post in the same envelope. A separate entry form should be completed for each unit.

All information provided by you will be stored in accordance with current legislation. A copy of this information can be made available to you on request to the Entries Officer, as named overleaf. The Organisers promise not to sell your details to anyone else.

You agree not to undertake any trading whatsoever, including the advertisement of boats, caravans or tents for sale, from the camping unit covered by this entry. Exhibition entry forms are available on request. You agree not to invite news, or other media (including television companies) to report or film without the written agreement of the Organisers.

### Notes

Packs containing information about the Festival, details of Festival awards and pitch locations will be posted out by about 1st May 2010. If you have not received your pack by mid-May, please contact the Entries Officer.

Your booking fee is for your entire stay. This includes entry to the Festival during opening hours and for evening entertainment. The campsite opens at 1.00 p.m. on 28th May 2010 and closes at 1.00 p.m. on 1st June 2010.

One plaque will be made available for each camping unit entering and attending the Festival. Plaques are not provided for camping units that enter but do not attend the Festival.
